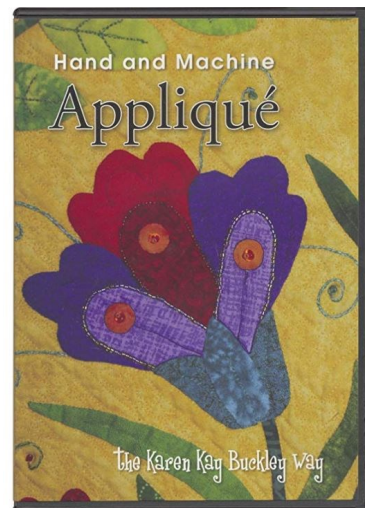


5, 6 and 7. Patterns have not been determined yet, as she is releasing some new patterns soon that we may wish to offer as class projects. Stay tuned!

Minutes of the September 6, 2018

Guild Meeting from Ellen Anson

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 by President, Beverly Williamson.

The minutes from the August meeting were published in the newsletter. A motion was made to approve the minutes as printed. The motion was seconded and approved.

The treasurer's report was published in the newsletter. A motion was made and seconded to approve the report as printed. The motion passed.

Shirley Hamilton, VP of Special Events, will accept money at the end of the meeting for Sit and Sew and Friday Night Drive In. She will be accepting payment at the door of the event as well. Friday Night Drive IN will be from 6 p.m. until 11. Those participating in Sit and Sew the next day can leave machines and supplies set up overnight. Beverly announced that she still needs two committee chairs to

share Sit and Sew organization. This person would be responsible for being in the building by 8:30 as doors open at 9. Chair would also need to collect money for the treasurer and leave the key upon leaving. Beverly also announced that a chair for Quilts of Valor is still needed.

A refurbished laptop has been ordered to be used by the Treasurer.

Shelby Looney, chair of Piecemakers, reported that the next event will be in October. Anyone interested in participating needs to message or call Shelby to sign up. The New Years Bash will be in December and will be three days.

Membership chair, Janet Mikes, reported that there were 59 members present, 3 visitors, and 4 new members. Janet announced that members need to be wearing a purchased or made nametag to be eligible for the monthly nametag drawing. Cost of purchasing a name tag is \$10.

After Show and Tell, Ellen Anson presented the challenge entries and their makers. Winners were announced from viewer's choice in 3 categories from the ballots that were submitted before the meeting.

In April of 2019, Laura Heine, collage quilt artist, will present a lecture and classes. Specific workshops that she will be teaching have not yet been chosen, awaiting new patterns that she has coming out.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:54.

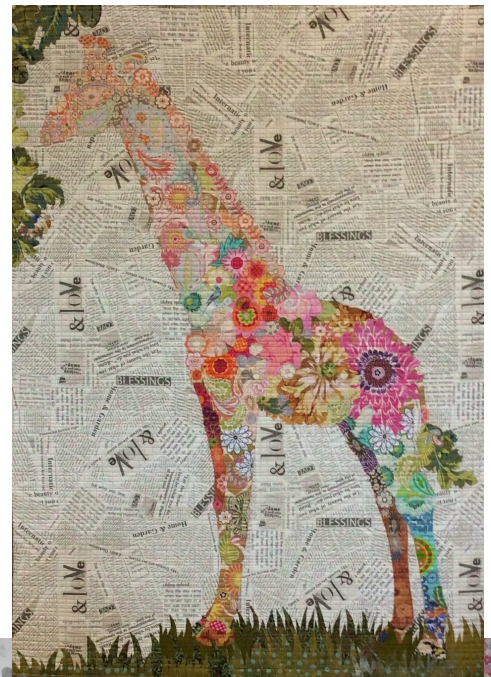
