## The Midnight Sun

BOM Pattern by Janna Thomas

## Supplies

6" x 12" or 6" x 24" ruler Rotary cutter Cutting mat 18" x 24" Neutral thread Fine pins, preferably with glass heads Mechanical pencil, fine point or some thing that you can see on light or dark fabrics

#### Bloc Loc HST ruler 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"

The 6 1/2" ruler will trim every unit in this pattern, however if you already have a 2 1/2", 3 1/2" and 4 1/2", you will find them very handy for fast and easy trimming of HST, QST, and BIA.




## Yardage

3 1/2 YD



2 1/2 YD



Backing Fabric 2 1/2 YD of 108" fabric

Batting 89 1/2" x 89 1/2" or Queen size in package

Binding 5/8 YD

#### Sewing Test

Cut (3) 2" x 5" pieces of scrap fabric. Sew them together lengthwise and then press the seams to one side. The completed piece should measure 5" x 5". If it isn't, then make adjustments to your seam allowance and try it again.

- Officers will be installed in December Zoom Guild Meeting



Marshall shared this from his studio in Carolton, Georgia and Jenna shared from Loveland, Colorado. They focused their lecture on the meaning behind the colors in the "My Mandela" quilt. They shared other quilts from their collections that use the Bloc Loc Rulers.

There will be a Sew-Along starting in January that features the Bloc Loc Ruler. It is a "Boot Camp" that Jenna and Marshal usually offer through local quilt shops. However, due to the pandemic, they are offering it to our guild. It will be a six month program and will cost \$40. Marshall will coach participants through the process virtually on Saturdays. These sessions will also be live and recorded for people that choose to partici-




